# School fees and the new CLEAR levy will be billed to you at the beginning of Term 1 each year and are payable in full unless a payment plan commitment has been made.

#### All payment plan commitments MUST be made before week 2 of Term 1.

School Card concessions are available. You will need to apply at the beginning of each year to the Department of Education School Card Scheme to receive a School Card discount. #### Horizon 2024 Year Book:

The Horizon 2024 Year Book is at the printer and on schedule to be available towards the end of this term. Each school family from 2024 will receive a complimentary copy.

#### Family Database Check – Email Link sent to all families:

The Family Database check was sent via an email link last week. Thank you to the many families who followed this up prior to the commencement of school. Links will be re-sent to families who have not completed this important check. It is important that we have accurate information to enable us to care for your child/ren. If you have any questions about this, or are having trouble accessing the link, please contact the school and we will do our best to ensure your information is correct and up to date.

#### Roll Call – Bus Management System:

All bus families are required to use Roll Call. This is an important form of communication between home and school, and ensures your child is best looked after during travel to and from school. If you need a registration email sent, please contact the office.

If you know your child is going o be absent from the bus, we encourage you to use Roll Call to notify the driver. This allows the buses to leave on time.

We encourage students to care for their issued bus tag. The price for a replacement bus tag is \$10. Thank you for your ongoing support.





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#### Hats:

As per our Extreme Weather Policy: HATS

During Term 1 and Term 4, hats must be always worn when students/staff are outside. Students not wearing a hat during recess and lunch times or during other outdoor activities will be sent to the 'No Hat zones' for the duration of the outdoor activity/ break time.

New hats are available from our Uniform Shop at a cost of \$17. Thank you for your support with this.

#### Extreme Weather Policy:

I include this information as it is highly likely that we will continue to have hot weather at this time of year. From our Extreme Weather Policy:

During 'Extreme Heat' weather, recess time for students will still be spent outdoors <u>in undercover/ shade</u> areas only. Students will be encouraged NOT to take part in strenuous physical activities.

An 'Extreme Heat' bell will be rung just before lunch when the temperature is over 38 degrees Celsius. Students are encouraged to remain outdoors in undercover or shade areas. Students are NOT able to take part in strenuous physical activities. There will be classrooms available for Primary and Secondary students to spend their lunch time in, should they feel the outside temperature is too hot for them.

#### Working With Children Check (WWCC):

As part of a Government requirement, anyone wishing to volunteer their time (helping in classrooms, or going on camps or excursions), is required to have a current Working With Children Check. These can be obtained through the school and for volunteers, are free. Please contact the school if you would like to register for a WWCC. A reminder to current volunteers, a WWCC only last 5 years, and will need to be renewed after such time.

#### Student Medical Care plans:

Our First Aid Policy aims to always ensure the health and safety of students. To do this staff must have accurate medical information. Parents and/or guardians are responsible, in relation to their children and/or those in their care for:

- Keeping the school informed of any medical conditions, treatments, and medical contact details.
- Providing staff with appropriate information and training/instruction where medical conditions require specialised treatment.
- Updating the school on any changes in medical conditions and/or required treatments. Students who have a medical care plan (Asthma, Medication, Diabetes etc) are required to update

them <u>annually.</u> Please provide a copy of these to the front office at your earliest convenience.
