- With time spent reflecting on their schooling journey, setting goals for the future and reflecting on God's goodness and blessing in their lives.



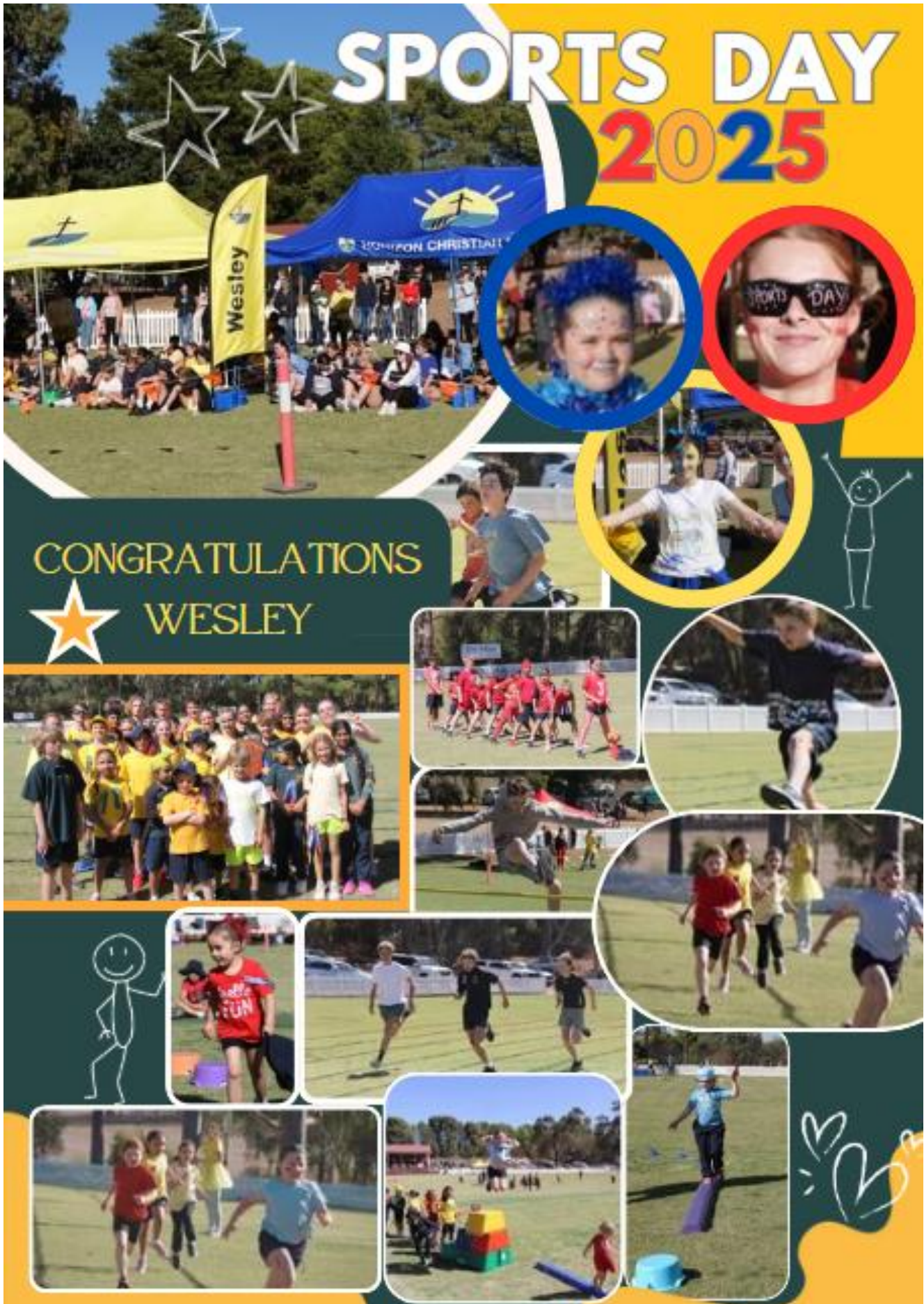
Roll Call – Important message for families using Horizon buses:
