Clare Dental Partners

Dental Services in the Clare Valley

We would like to share an important update regarding access to dental care for children in the Clare Valley area.

Dear Schools, Parents & Caregivers,

SA Dental Clare is no longer providing dental services. Instead, SA Dental has contracted local Dental Clinics to provide Dental services for children.

There are two main dental schemes available for children:

1. **The Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS)** is available through Medicare for families meeting the eligibility criteria. Families can check their child's eligibility by logging into Medicare Online or via the Medicare App. Under this scheme, eligible children can access up to \$1,158 over a two-year period (from 2026) for dental services.
2. **Country Child Dental Scheme (CCDS)** through SA Dental. Under the Country Child Dental Scheme, ALL children are eligible for up to \$357.80 per calendar year to cover dental services such as a check-up, clean, and X-rays. Further funding can be applied for specific additional treatment at the discretion of the practice (check with the practice).

In addition to these schemes, children are also entitled to one sports mouthguard each year, which is fully covered.

We hope this information assists families in accessing local dental care for their children in the absence of the SA Dental Clinic.
