Eight middle school students from the Clare and Balaklava campuses proudly represented Horizon Christian School at the Pedal Prix held at the Shell V-Power Motorsport Park on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. The six-hour event saw students work together to complete continuous laps of the 2.8km track, finishing with an impressive 62 laps overall. Out of 170 teams, Horizon placed 106th overall, 18th in their category and achieved an outstanding 2nd place in their division.

Congratulations also to Josiah, who completed the team's fastest lap in 4 minutes and 14 seconds, averaging 40km/h. Students enjoyed the experience and the opportunity to race on a professional track.
